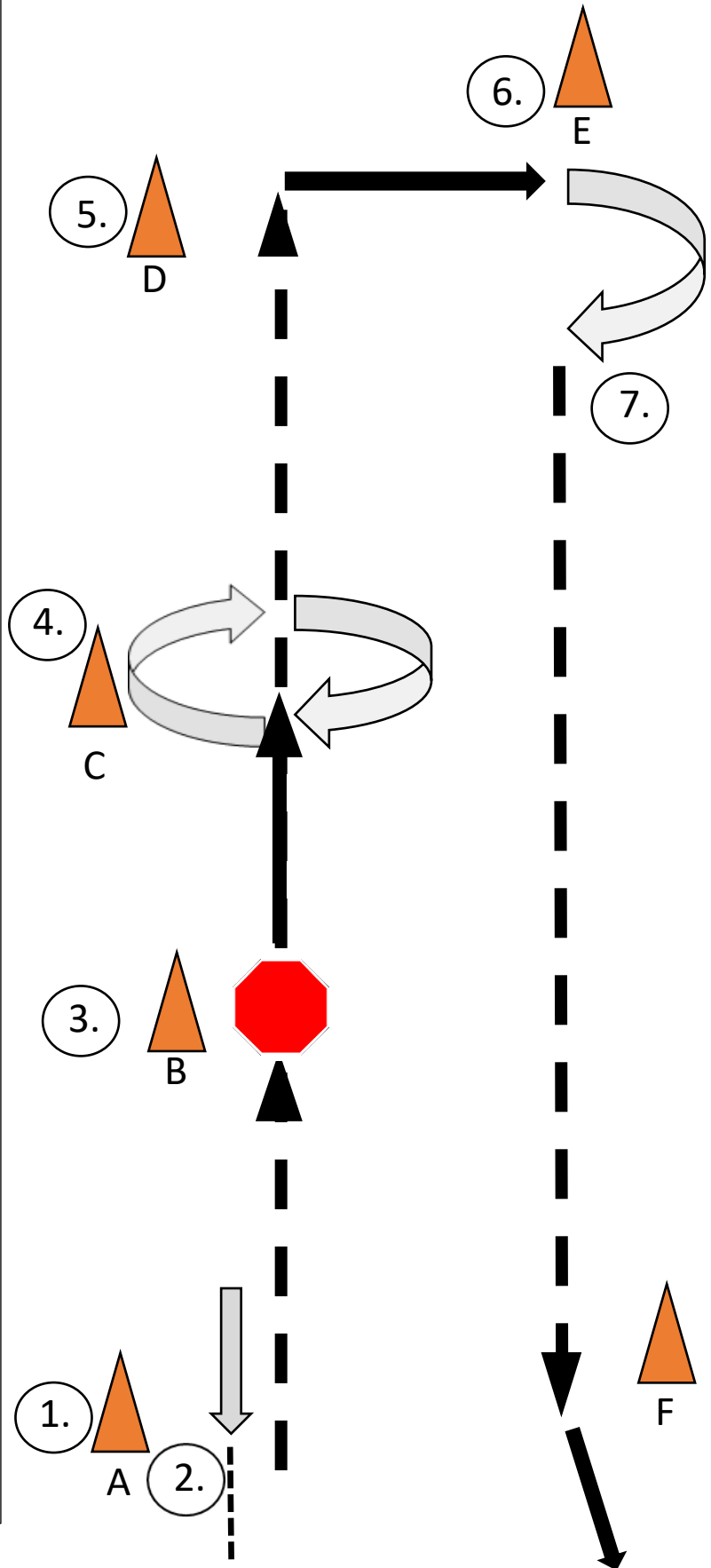
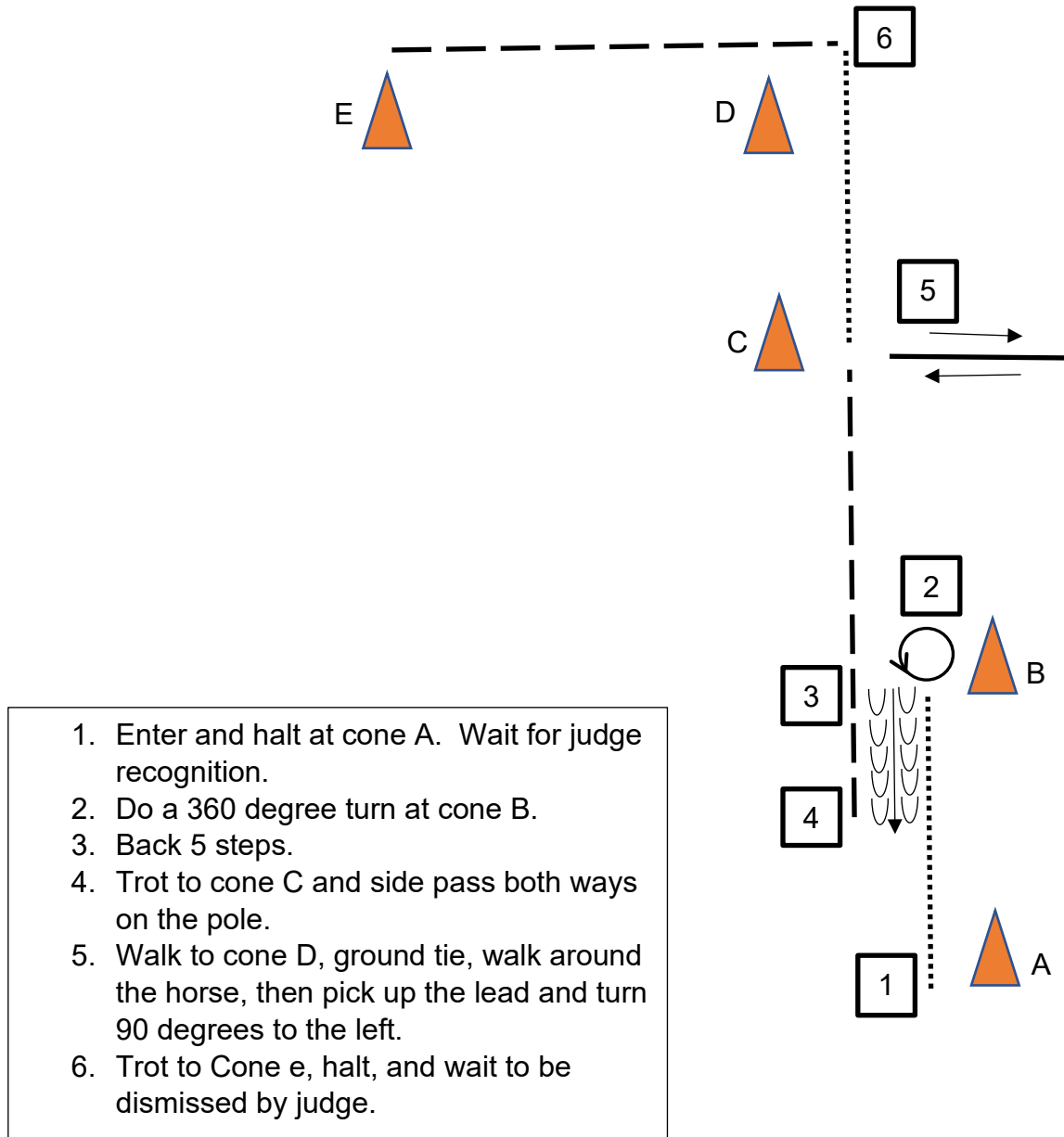


New England 4-H Horse Show – In Hand Suitability

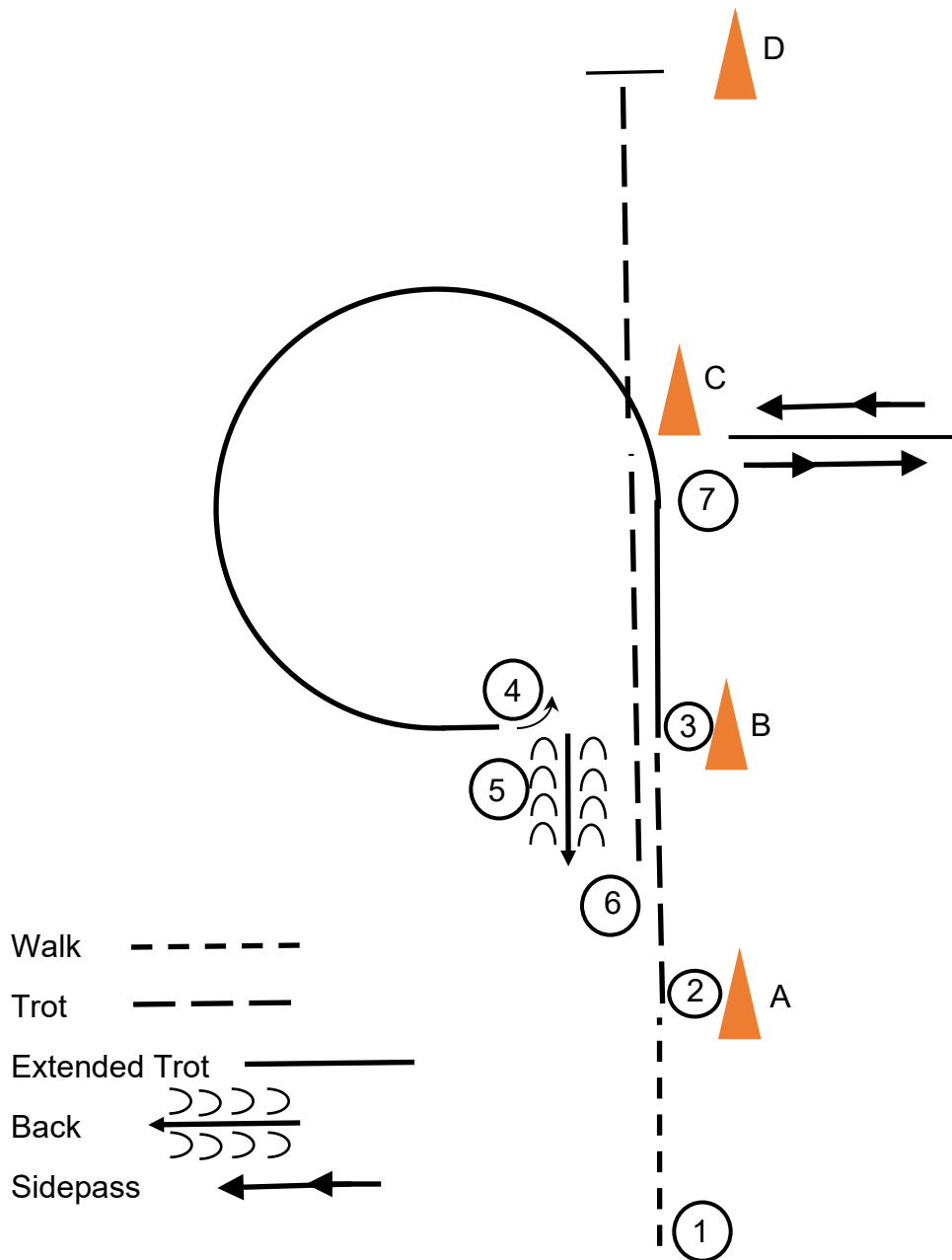
1. Begin at Cone A, as pattern indicates.
2. Upon the signal from the judge, back your horse 5 steps and then trot to Cone B.
3. At Cone B, stop and stand perfectly still for a count of 7 seconds.
4. Walk to Cone C. Stop and execute a 360 degree pivot on the haunches, to the right.
5. Trot to Cone D. Halt, then side pass right until Cone E is in front of your horse.
6. Ground tie your horse and walk a full circle around him/her in either direction. Pick up lead and execute a 180 degree pivot to the right.
7. Trot to Cone F and then walk to lineup area.

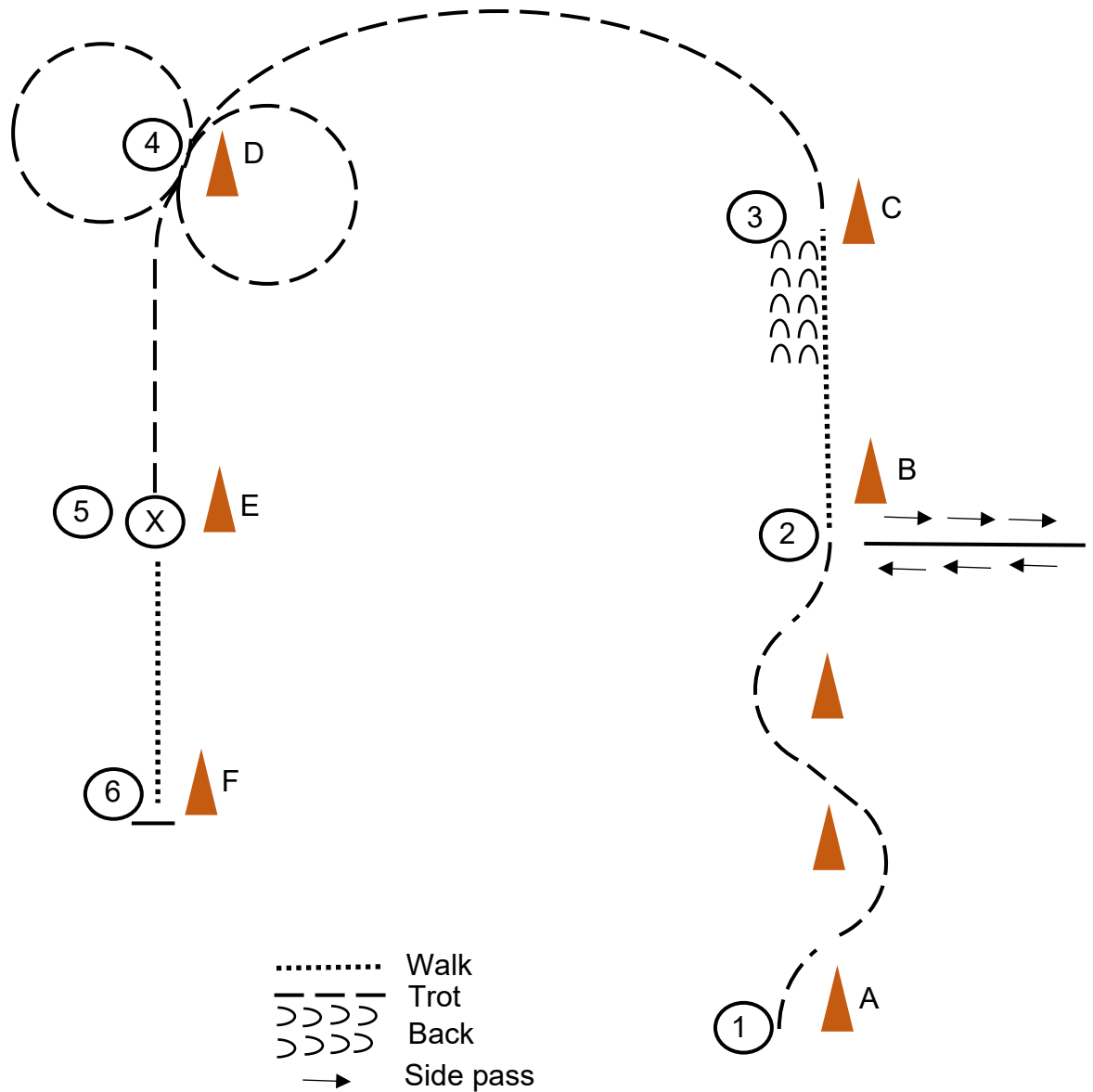


In Hand Suitability



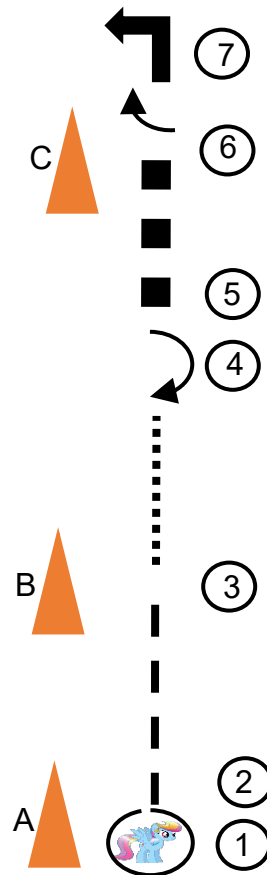
1. Enter and walk to cone A.
2. Trot from cone A to cone B.
3. At cone B extend trot to the left and circle at cone C as shown. Stop facing cone B.
4. Turn 1/4 turn to the left.
5. Back one horse length.
6. Trot to cone C and stop. Side pass right, then back to left.
7. Trot to cone D and wait to be dismissed.

In-Hand Suitability



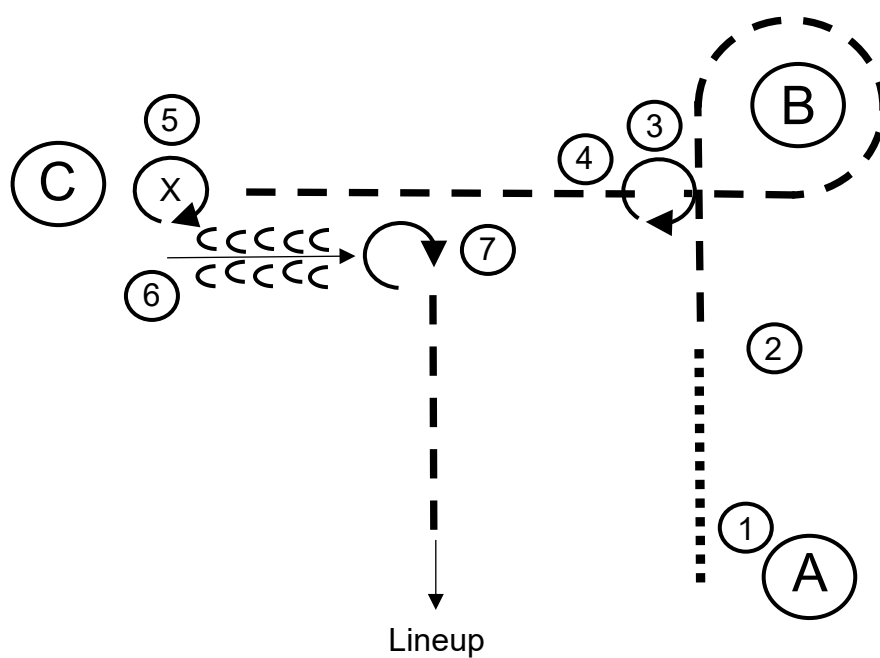
1. Enter and stop at cone A. Wait to be recognized by judge, then trot to through cones to cone B.
2. Stop at cone B and side pass both ways, then walk to cone C.
3. Stop at cone C and back 5 steps. Trot to cone D.
4. Extend the trot and do the figure 8 pattern, then continue to cone E.
5. Stop and ground tie, walk around your horse, pick up lead and walk to cone F
6. Halt and wait to be dismissed.

In Hand Suitability



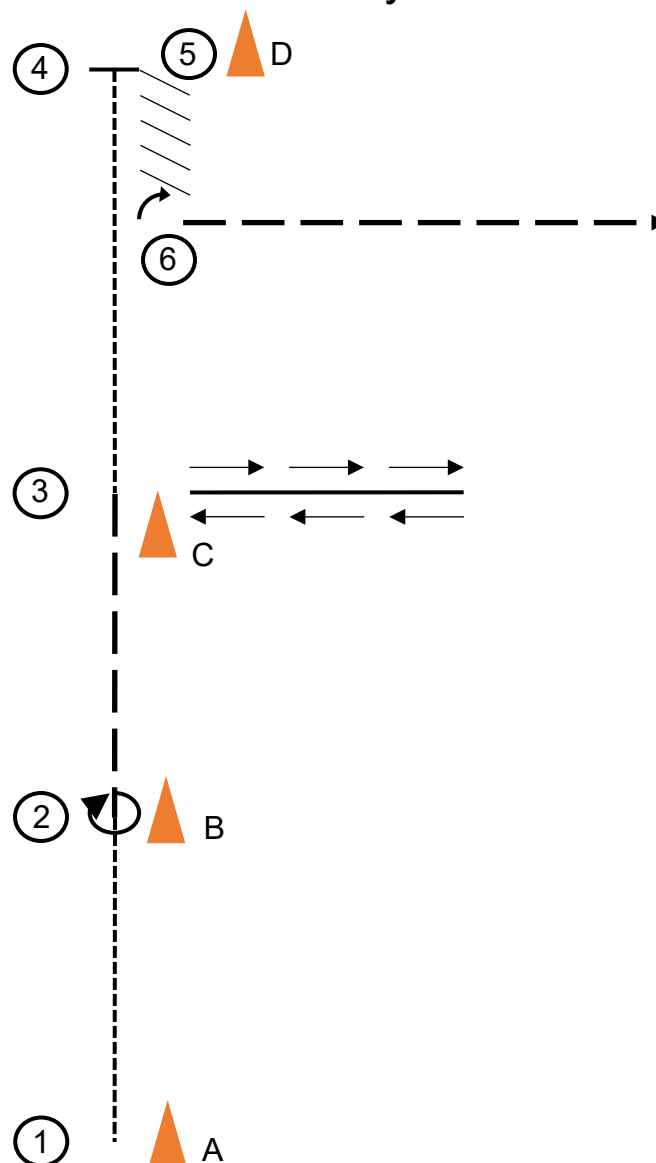
1. Ground tie at cone A. Walk around your horse.
2. Trot to cone B.
3. At cone B transition to a walk.
4. Half way to cone C halt for 3 seconds and then do a 180 degree turn to the right.
5. Back to cone C.
6. Do a 90 degree turn to the right.
7. Wait for dismissal from the judge and then exit to lineup.

In Hand Suitability



1. Start at A and walk halfway to B.
2. Trot to and around B as shown.
3. Stop when past B and perform a 360 degree turn.
4. Do extended trot to C.
5. Ground tie. Walk around horse and pick up lead.
6. Back one horse length.
7. Perform a 270 degree turn and trot to lineup.

In Hand Suitability



Be at 1 ready to start pattern.

1. Trot from cone A to cone B.
2. Do 360 degree turn at cone B. Walk to cone C.
3. Do side pass both ways.
4. Trot from cone C to cone D. Stop and set up.
5. Back five steps.
6. Turn 90 degrees to right and walk to line-up.
