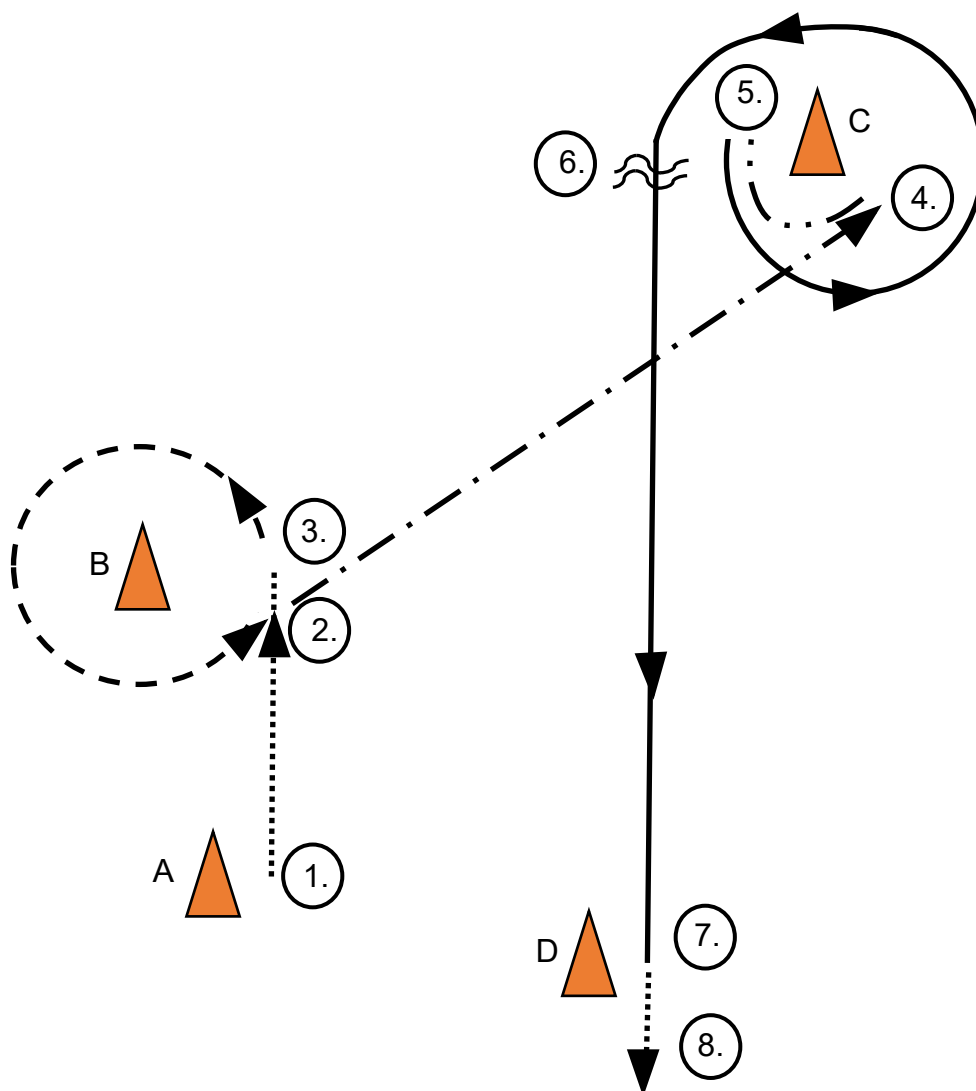


English and Western Equitation Pattern



1. Start walk at cone A.
2. Pick up trot/jog and circle cone B.
3. When circle is closed extend the trot/job to Cone C.
4. Back around cone C as shown.
5. Canter/Lope around cone C on left lead.
6. When you are even with cone C at the close of your circle do a simple or flying lead change to the right lead to cone D.
7. Stop at cone D and do a 360 degree turn on the haunches to the right.
8. Walk forward and exit.

- . - . - Extended Trot/Jog

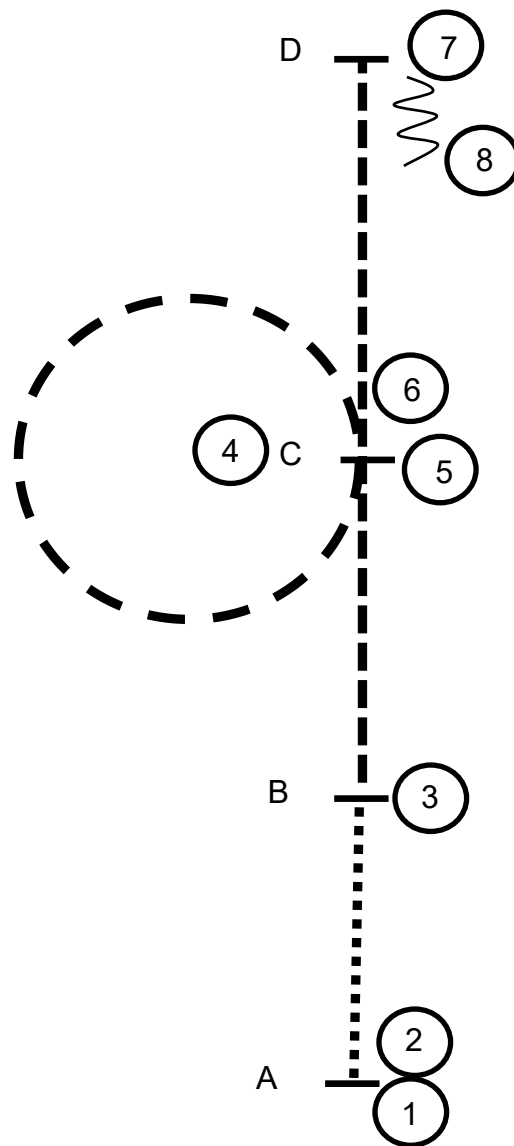

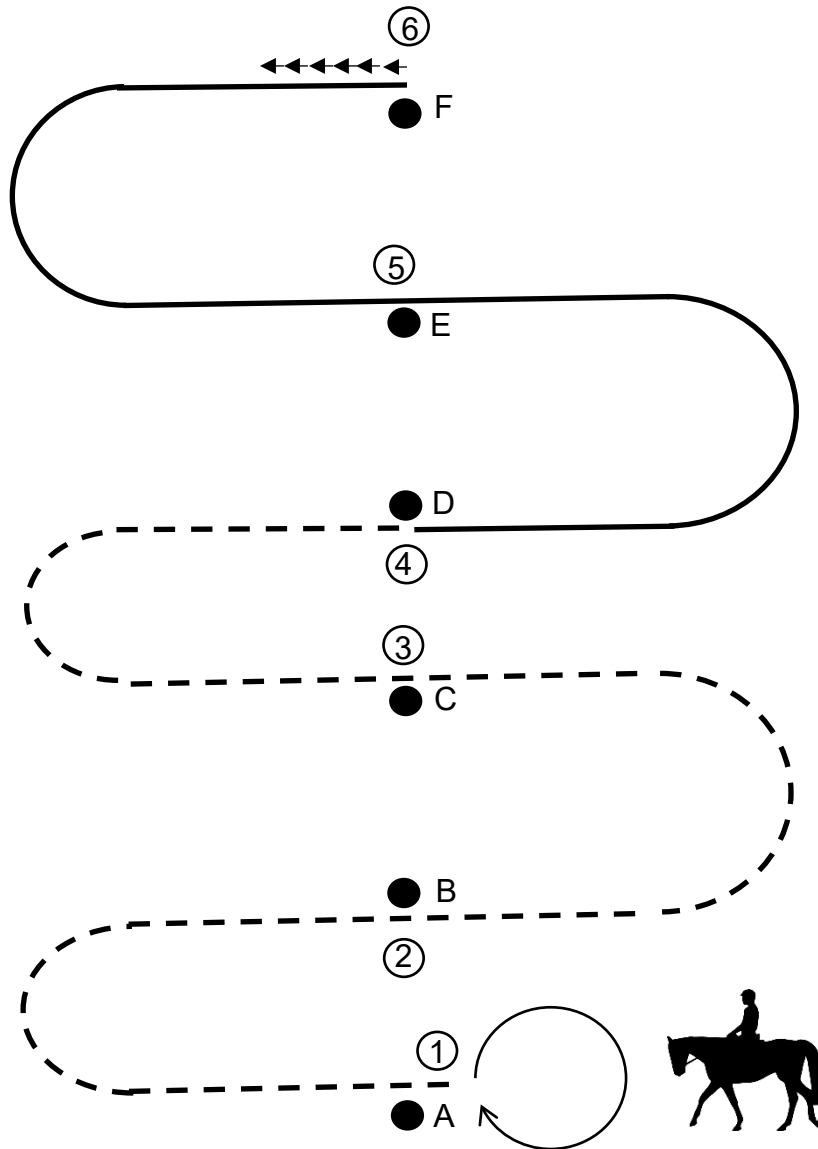
Lead Change

English and Western Equitation



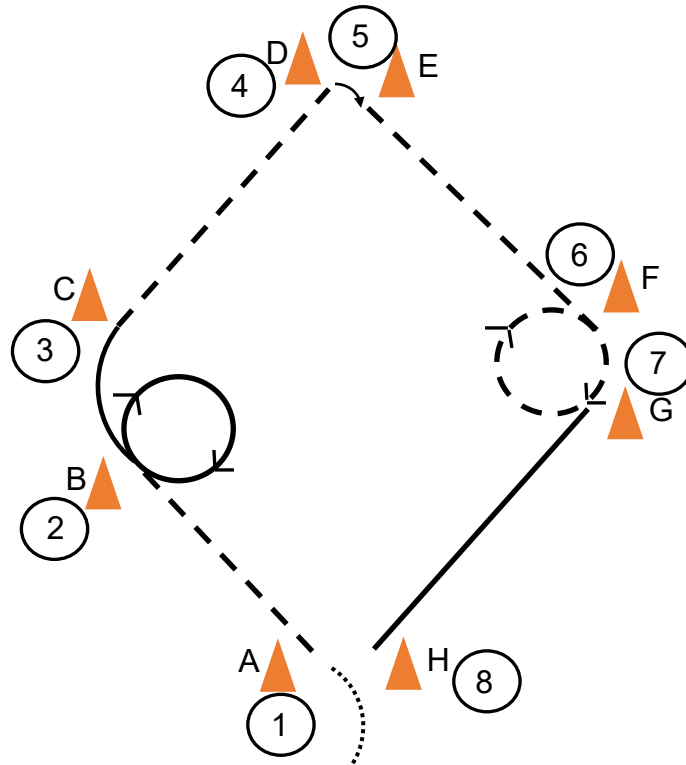
1. Halt on the right side of A and wait for the judge.
2. Walk to B.
3. At B Trot/Jog (English riders must be on the correct diagonal).
4. Trot/Jog a small circle around C as shown.
5. At C Halt for 5 seconds.
6. Canter/Lope from C to D (Riders must use the **RIGHT lead; not the correct lead**).
7. **Halt at D. Back up 5 steps.**
8. **Halt and wait for the judge's dismissal.**

English and Western Equitation Pattern



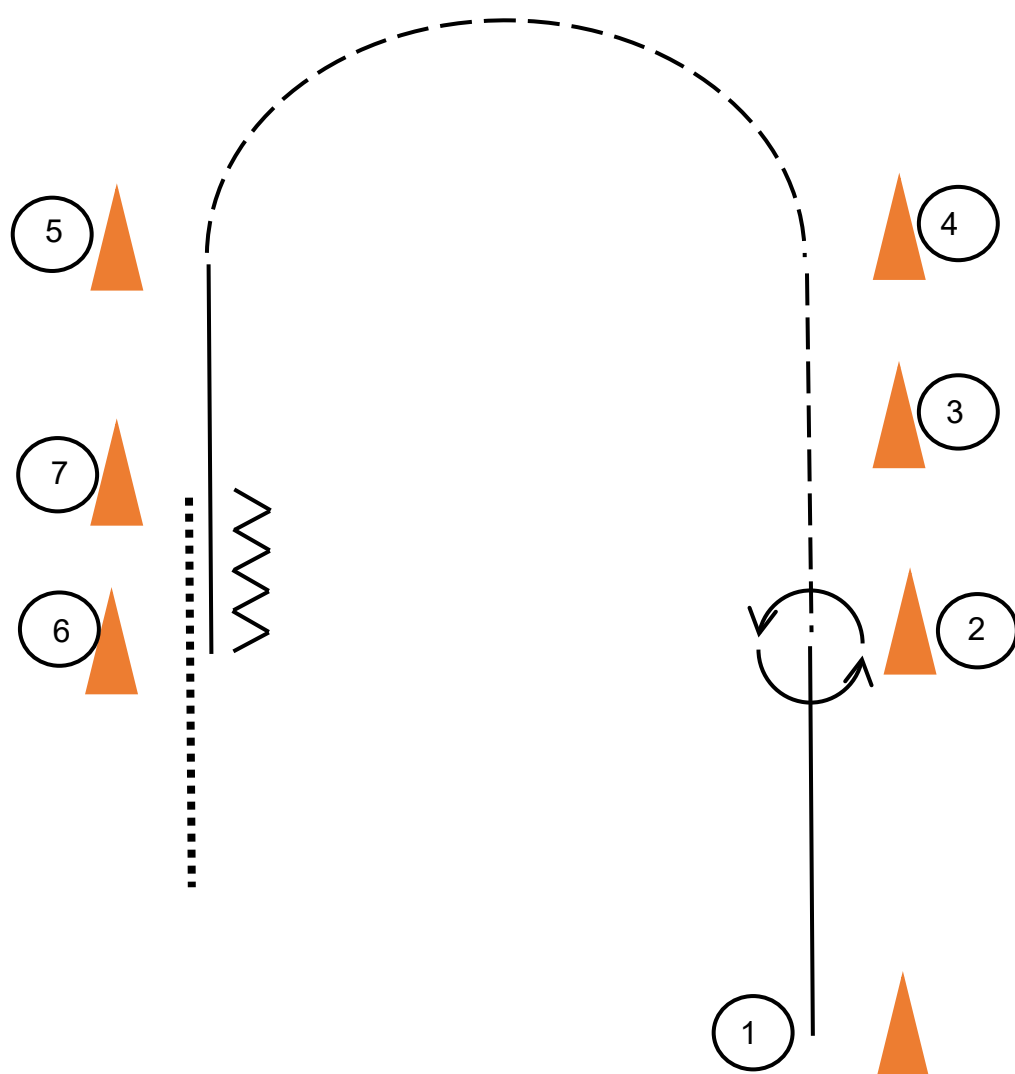
1. 360 degree pivot turn to the right, trot or jog correct diagonal to cone B on right side of cone.
2. Trot or jog correct diagonal to cone C on right side of cone.
3. Sitting trot or jog to cone D on right side of cone.
4. Canter or lope left lead to cone E, simple lead change on right side of cone.
5. Canter or lope right lead to cone F on left side of cone.
6. Stop and back 6 steps, wait to be dismissed.

English and Western Equitation



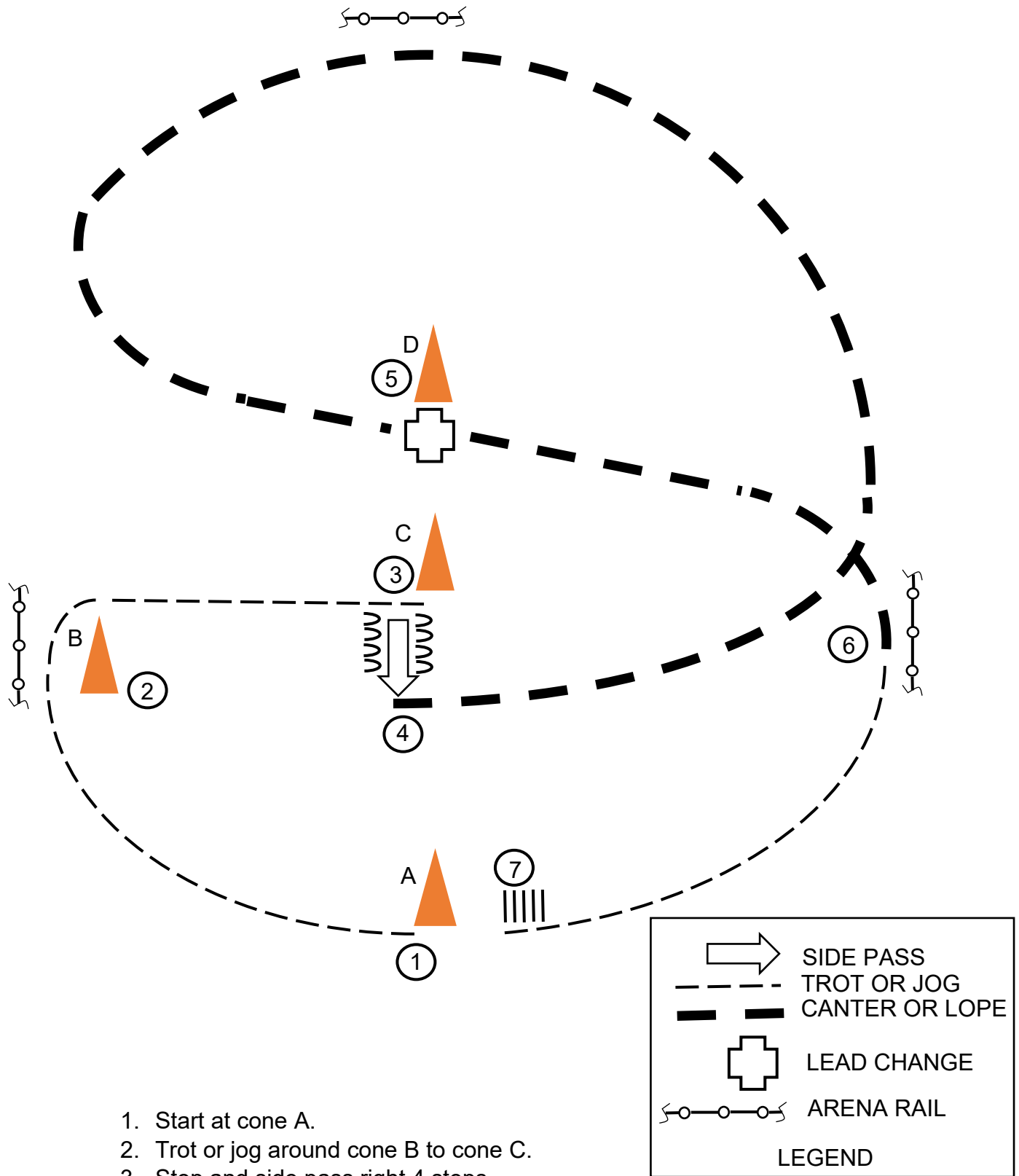
1. Enter and walk to cone A. Halt and wait to be recognized by judge. Trot or jog to cone B.
2. At cone B canter or lope a circle on the right lead.
3. At cone C, change to trot (on the right diagonal) or jog to cone D.
4. Halt at cone D and do a 90 degree turn to the right.
5. Pick up a trot (on the left diagonal) or jog at cone E.
6. At cone F, trot or jog a circle to the right.
7. At cone G pick up a canter or lope on the left lead.
8. Halt at cone H and wait to be dismissed.

English and Western Equitation

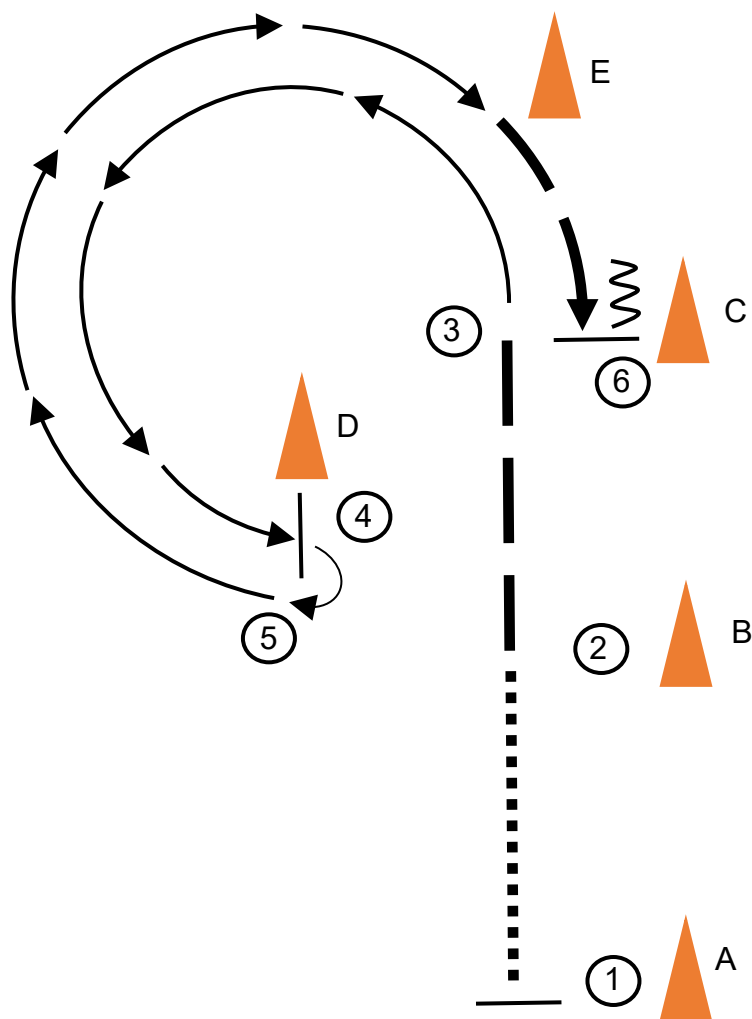


1. Canter or lope, left lead.
2. Halt and do a 360 degree turn.
3. Pick up an extended jog or trot on the correct diagonal.
4. Change to a normal trot or jog (sitting trot).
5. Canter or lope, right lead.
6. Halt and back 4 steps.
7. Walk to exit.

English and Western Equitation



English and Western Equitation



1. Walk from cone A to cone B.
2. At cone B, trot/jog to come C.
3. At cone C, lope/canter a circle to the left to cone D, then stop.
4. At cone D, do a 180 degree hindquarter pivot to the right.
5. Lope/canter a circle to the right back to cone E; trot/jog to cone C and stop.
6. Back 5 steps. Wait to be dismissed.
